These funds will help homeowners repair their homes and provide other resources to help them on their road to recovery. The funds are restricted to only the disaster areas declared in 2008. Call 877-847-2211 or dial 2-1-1 to find out if you are eligible to receive assistance. Don't delay. The program ends September 30, 2010.

The 30 counties include: Adams, Calumet, Columbia, Crawford, Dane, Dodge, Fond du Lac, Grant, Green, Green Lake, Iowa, Jefferson, Juneau, Kenosha, La Crosse, Manitowoc, Marquette, Milwaukee, Monroe, Ozaukee, Racine, Richland, Rock, Sauk, Sheboygan, Vernon, Walworth, Washington, Waukesha and Winnebago.
